More later.....

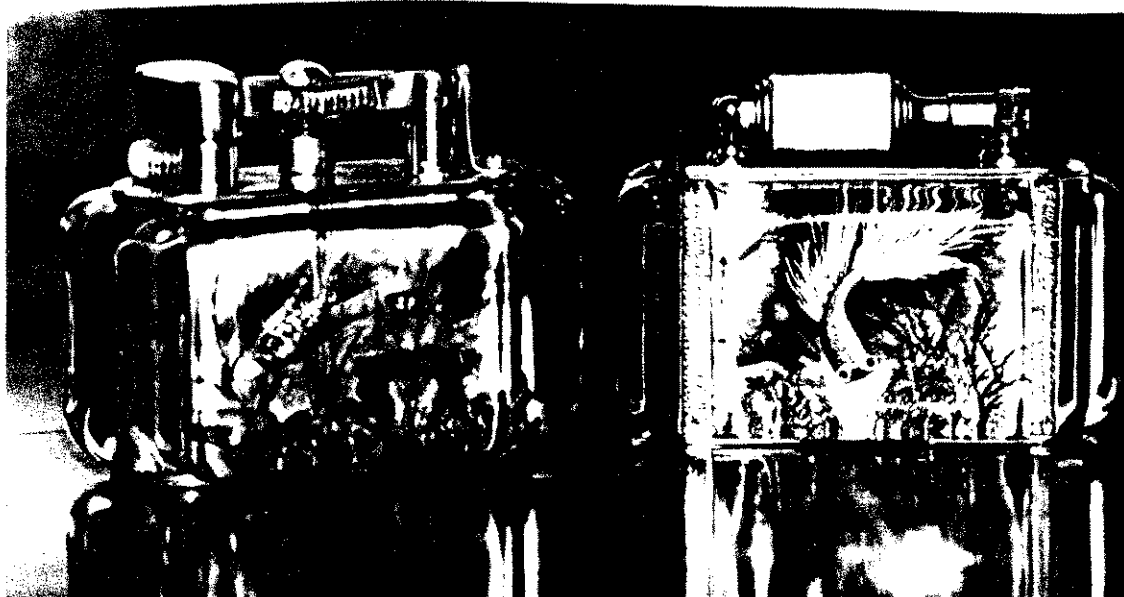

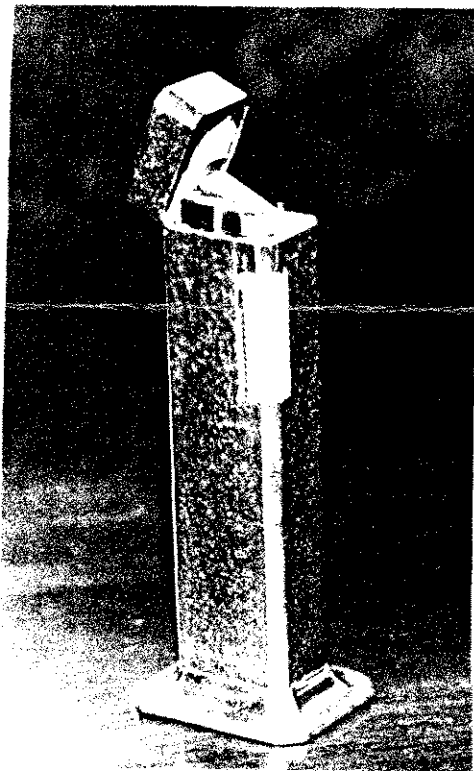

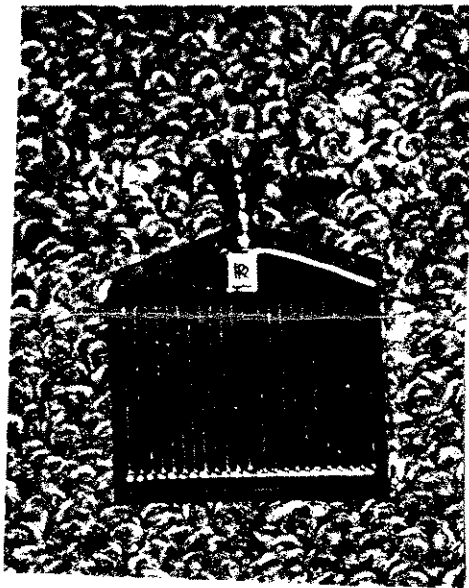
Front and back side of the Erie 1865-78 lighter.



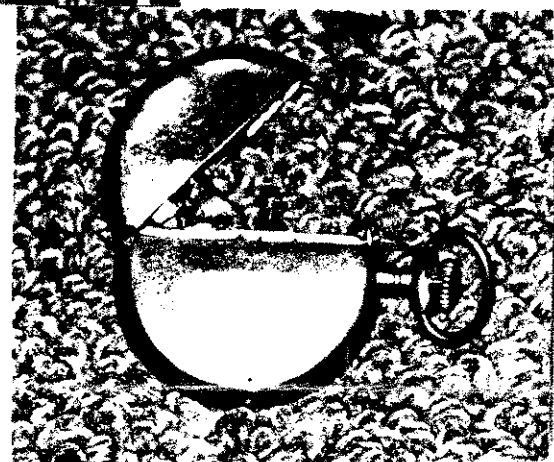

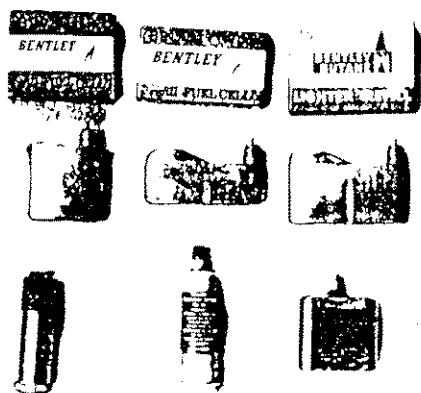
